

Bury and District Ladies' Golf Association Championship 2018

On Sunday 10th June at Pike Fold Golf Club the qualifying round for the Bury and District Golf Association Ladies Championship took place,.

Pike Fold golf course was presented in superb condition and ladies certainly appreciated it.

The four best gross scores qualify to play in the semi finals on the Monday evening, this saw Clare MacLeod(Harwood) first qualifier playing Bev Dodd(Rosendale Lady Captain) and Amelia Taylor second qualifier (Harwood) playing Ellie May Looker(Brightmet).

The first semi final between Clare and Bev, was until the 11th hole a very closely fought match, however the 11th hole saw Clare take command winning both the 11th & 12th holes and eventually coming out the winner 2&1, the second semi final between Amelia and Ellie May was an extremely close affair with the match swinging backwards and forwards with Amelia winning the match on the 20th hole.

This meant a final between 2 Harwood members Clare & Amelia, Clare a past Ladies Champion and Amelia the current Ladies champion. This match was very evenly matched with nothing more than one hole in it until the turn came when Amelia birdied the 10th hole. After a brief fight back by Clare, Amelia went on to win the match 4&3 and retain the title she won the previous year at Bury Golf Club.

All ladies participating in the semi finals should be commended for the manner in which they conducted themselves plus the standard of golf they produced and after comments made by the watching spectators 15 year old Ellie May is a champion in the making
